- ✚ Guided by reflection/prayer, faculty, alums, parents will gather to share a meal, share stories, and share our ideas on how to live and lead as Lasallians, united in the Lasallian mission.
- ✚ This mission is often expressed in Five Core Principles: Respect for All Persons, Faith in the Presence of God, Concern for the Poor and Social Justice, Inclusive Community, and Quality Education.
- ✚ In order to explore each of these principles and how they relate to each other, following a directed reflection, we will sit down to a five-course meal that corresponds with each of the five core principles.
 - Appetizer—Faith in the Presence of God
 - Salad—Inclusive Community
 - Bread—Concern for the Poor and Social Justice
 - Main Course—Quality of Education
 - Dessert—Respect for All Persons
- ✚ At a designated evening during this semester, five members from this group will each lead a section of the reflection.
- ✚ At a designated evening next semester, five other members from this group will each lead a section of the reflection.
