

## La Salle University – Parking, Directions and Transit Information

### DETAILED DIRECTIONS FOR OUR SUMMIT PARKING, BUILDINGS, ETC.

#### **For those using a Taxi, Uber or another Car Service:**

- Give the driver the address of 1900 West Olney Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19141. This will take you to the corner of 20<sup>th</sup> Street and Olney Ave. Follow DVTA signs or ask Security to direct you to the La Salle Union Building, where the check-in is.

#### **For those driving themselves:**

- For the May 6 Summit, we are instructed to park in **Lot D** in the South Campus:

#### **Directions to South Campus Parking:**

From 20th St. and Olney Ave. (main campus address), proceed EAST on Olney Avenue and take a RIGHT onto Ogontz Avenue. Follow Ogontz Avenue past the Armory and take a RIGHT at the light onto Lindley Avenue. Entrance to South Campus Parking is on your RIGHT. Proceed up road and Parking Lot D will be on your RIGHT.

**Note to GPS Users:** Although the Lindley Avenue entrance for Lot D does not have an exact address for a GPS, the closest one would be *1800 Lindley Avenue*, but you will need to proceed past this address and make a right into the driveway for the Lot D parking. If you reach Belfield Avenue after turning off of Ogontz onto Lindley, you have gone too far. The lot is *halfway* between Ogontz and Belfield on Lindley.

If there is a guard at the security kiosk, let him/her know you are headed to the La Salle Union building (**#48 on the campus map**) for the program sponsored by The Delaware Valley Translators Association. We should also have DVTA directional signs posted for you to follow as you proceed on foot to the theatre. But in case they're not up when you arrive, here are further details:

Once you park in Lot D, you will walk the path up the hill and between the athletic fields. You will make a RIGHT at the end of the baseball field, and a LEFT at the first driveway. The entrance to the Union building is will be on the LEFT (you will see a patio with several doors leading to the main lobby).

**Please note: 20th Street is one-way now, and it only runs northward. If you are coming from Broad and Olney, you would just make a LEFT onto Ogontz and follow the same directions above.**

### RAIL/BUS TRANSPORTATION TO LA SALLE UNIVERSITY

(1900 W. Olney Ave., Phila., PA 19141)

1. SEPTA (Southeastern Pennsylvania Transit Authority) Take any of the Regional Rail Lines to Suburban Station and then take the Broad Street Subway Line northbound to the Broad & Olney station. \*\*Broad Street is Philly's "14th" street. So, you can either walk 5 blocks west to 19th & Olney or take either the 18 or 26 bus routes westbound. Once you reach La Salle's campus, follow "DVTA" directional signs to walk to the La Salle Union Building.
2. SEPTA Buses: Routes 18 or 26 run along Olney Avenue. Take buses from your area of the City to either of these lines and then transfer. Visit [www.septa.org](http://www.septa.org) to plan your trip via bus or use the contact information given below.
3. SEPTA Market-Frankford Elevated/Subway Line – Take this to City Hall and transfer for free to the Broad Street Line. Take this northbound to Broad & Olney and then follow directions starting with \*\* in point 1 above.
4. If coming by rail via AMTRAK, you can use your ticket from 30<sup>th</sup> Street Station to ride the Market/Frankford subway line eastbound to City Hall for no additional cost. At City Hall, take the Broad Street Line northbound to Broad & Olney and then follow directions starting with \*\* in point 1 above. Or you can hire a taxi or car service to take you to La Salle's campus (Give driver the address of 1900 West Olney Avenue, Philadelphia, PA 19141 and see above instructions for taxi and Uber). Visit [www.amtrak.com](http://www.amtrak.com) or call 1-800-872-7245 to make an Amtrak reservation or to find out information about the Amtrak station nearest you.
5. Megabus (<https://www.megabus.com/>) and Bolt Bus (<https://www.boltbus.com/>) also arrive in Philadelphia just outside 30th Street Station.

6. The PATCO Highspeed train (Lindenwold Highspeed line) from New Jersey will stop at the 12<sup>th</sup>/13<sup>th</sup> & Locust Stop and connect with the Broad Street subway which you can take northbound to Broad & Olney and then follow directions starting with \*\* in point 1 above.

SEPTA Buses, trains and trolleys cost \$2.25/one way.

The PATCO line from New Jersey will cost you anywhere from \$1.15 to \$2.45 one way, depending on your station of origin. For more information, visit <http://www.ridepatco.org/schedules/schedules.asp> or call 856-772-6900 or 215-922-4600.
