You are invited to submit an abstract for a breakout session to be presented during the 2019 Huether Lasallian Conference that will address the conference theme:

Living the Lasallian Mission: Celebrating with Zeal

WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR

The 2019 Huether Planning Committee is accepting abstracts for breakout session presentations of 75-minutes in length that will take place during concurrent sessions in the afternoon on Friday, November 22, 2019.

Presentations should focus on how Lasallian communities and ministries are addressing the theme, “Living the Lasallian Mission: Celebrating with Zeal.”

Breakout session presentations will share the transformative power of how our Lasallian mission calls us to touch hearts of those entrusted to our care. Please reference [Lasallian Reflection 4](#) as the foundational document for this year’s Huether Conference. The planning committee has surfaced the following as possible topics for the breakout sessions:

- Mutual Accompaniment/Mentorship Programs (new faculty/staff, students, graduate support, alumni)
- Spiritual Direction/Discernment (programs for faculty/staff or students or retreat/reflective processes)
- Pedagogy of the Heart
 - Programs or best practices that accompany students in their growth process
 - Programs or best practices that help students learn and develop new skills and attitudes, new personal and social values.
- Initial and Continuing Professional Development on the local level
- Lasallian Leadership Dynamics and Practices in Community on the local level

- Lasallian Charism in the Classroom/Workplace
 - How are De La Salle's teachings experienced in a core content classroom?
 - How are De La Salle's teachings experienced in counseling or office settings?
- Lasallian Identity, Culture and Vocation
- Relationship/Community-building in a Lasallian Community (building up Lasallian community through my work)
- Young Lasallians and Lasallian Volunteers
 - How does the energy of Young Lasallians and Lasallian Volunteers invigorate a ministry?
 - How to touch the hearts of Young Lasallians and Lasallian Volunteers to get them committed to mission?

During each breakout session, the presenter(s) should focus on how we look at the present and to the future in light of the topic(s).

2. Preferred presentation format (multi-media presentation, interactive presentation, facilitated discussion, lecture-style, open forum, etc.)
3. Intended audience (A-all educators; E-elementary school faculty and staff; M-middle school faculty and staff; H-high school faculty and staff; C-college/university faculty and staff; YFS-youth and family services)
4. Objectives/intended outcomes for participants
5. Program abstract (no more than 200 words)
6. A/V needs (LCD projector, screen, lectern and internet for presenter will be provided; **presenter must provide own laptop**)
NOTE: If you are using a Mac computer, please bring the appropriate adapter.
7. Willingness to repeat session

NOTE: You will be notified by email of acceptance of your presentation. Accepted presenters (limited to two per session) will receive a \$100 reduction of the 2019 Huether Lasallian Conference registration fee. **All accepted presenters must be registered and paid in full by Friday, October 25, 2019, in order to present.**
