Dear Lasallians,

We hope this message finds you, your families and ministry communities safe and healthy. The Office for Lasallian Education at Christian Brothers Conference has been closely monitoring health alerts and advisories of the coronavirus pandemic while in ongoing communication and reflection with our partners on the advisability of holding the 2020 Lasallian Social Justice Institute (LSJI). At this time, we write with an update regarding this summer's LSJI.

After discussing several considerations, in consultation with the Districts and the Lasallian Education Council, and out of an abundance of care and caution, we are canceling the 2020 Lasallian Social Justice Institute OKI-NI-SOO-KA-WA "Come and See" at De La Salle Blackfeet School in Browning, Montana. The health and well-being of all involved in the program (participants, staff, presenters, facilitators and colleagues at De La Salle Blackfeet) were at the forefront of this decision. Conscious of travel plans, we wanted to get this information to you in a timely matter. We regret the present health crisis requires a change in plans.

For those who have registered to date, an email will come from Christian Brothers Conference outlining the registration refund process. At this time our plan is to reschedule for the summer of 2021. As soon as dates are confirmed for next summer, we will be sure to post them on www.lasallian.info. Registration will open in February 2021 for next summer's program. We continue to join with our Lasallian colleagues from around the world as Brother Superior Robert Schieler, FSC, invites us to "pray for all those suffering from this virus, those families who have lost loved ones and for the many doctors, nurses and first-responders putting their own health at risk."
