#### **Christian Brothers Conference (CBC) Hotel Reservation Policy**

The cost of a participant's hotel room is not included in the Huether Conference registration fee and is the sole responsibility of the participant. Participants will be asked on the registration form to acknowledge and agree to the conditions of this policy.

#### **Reservations**

Hotel reservations for the Huether Conference can be made online using a booking website that has been created specifically for the event. Please [click here](#) to make, modify or cancel hotel reservation online. Participants may also make reservations by phone by calling the toll-free group reservations phone number: 1-844-202-5932.

By using the Huether Conference online reservations link or the dedicated toll-free phone number above, **participants will receive the discounted conference rate of \$140.00 per person, per night.** The discounted conference rate is quoted exclusive of any applicable taxes (which are currently 9.50%), applicable service fees, and /or hotel-specific fees in effect at the time of the conference. This rate is available from Monday, November 14, through Tuesday, November 22, 2022,

based on availability. Participants should call the reservations toll-free number listed above if questions arise regarding reservations. **All reservations must be accompanied by the first night's room deposit or guaranteed by a major credit card.** The hotel will not hold any reservations unless secured by one of these methods.

### **Reservation Cut-off Date**

The cut-off date to make a reservation in the Huether Conference discounted room block is **5:00 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time (EDT), Tuesday, October 25, 2022, or until the block is sold out.** Please be sure to book your room early. After October 26, or if the block is sold out, the hotel will accept reservations on a space-available basis at the prevailing rate.

### **Check-in/Checkout**

Check-in time starts at 4:00 p.m., and checkout time is noon.

### **Cancellation**

Participants may cancel their reservation at no charge before 3:00 p.m., 48 hours prior to their arrival date. Please note that the hotel will charge a fee equal to one night's room and tax for cancellations after that time.

### **Hotel Parking**

At this time, valet parking is not available. The hotel's discounted self-parking rate is \$15.00 per day/night for conference participants with in/out access.

## **TRAVEL**

### **CBC Travel Policy**

All travel arrangements and costs, including airfare, train, bus and/or other ground transportation costs are the sole responsibility of the participant. Participants will be asked on the registration form to acknowledge and agree to the conditions of this policy.

### **Airport Information**

The Baltimore/Washington International Thurgood Marshall (BWI) Airport is conveniently located 10 miles (approximately 25 minutes) from by the Hyatt Regency Baltimore Inner Harbor. The hotel does not provide shuttle service. However, there are several ways to travel between the terminals and to the Inner Harbor Baltimore once you've arrived. They include:

### **Driving**

### **Taxi**

Taxi service is available on a first come, first serve basis from the lower-level curbs of all terminals. All taxis are metered.

### **Uber/Lyft/other app-based ride services**

Uber and Lyft are also available. If participants choose one of these services, it is highly recommended to download the service's app before heading to Baltimore. Participants can download the app directly to their iPhone from the App Store or to their Android device from the Google Play Store.

### **Car Rental Companies**

BWI has opened a spacious, rental car facility providing a one-stop rental car station for travelers. The facility is located at 7432 New Ridge Road, Hanover, MD. [Free shuttle service](#) carries customers to and from the airport approximately every 10 minutes. Passengers arriving on flights should take the [free shuttle](#) from the lower level terminal for a 10-minute ride to the new facility. When returning the car rental, look for highway directional signs to the facility.

### **SuperShuttle Express**

Take advantage of the SuperShuttle Express service available between BWI and the hotel. While reservations are not required, they are recommended for stress-free travel.

### [MTA Bus Service](#)

The Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Transit Administration (MDOT MTA) also offers weekday peak service on the [#75 bus](#) from BWI. **The travel time from the BWI Bus 75 stop to the hotel is approximately 1 hour and 14 minutes.** For bus fare and route information, please visit MDOT MTA at [mta.maryland.gov](http://mta.maryland.gov). To access 24-hour automated information, call 1.866.RIDE MTA. Travelers can also find information on how to download the Transit app and alternate ways to get-time information on [this website](#).

### [Commuter Rail](#)

The MTA Light Rail offers convenient access and reliable transportation to and from the airport. Take the BWI Airport Light Rail tram to Camden Station / Camden Yards. Your stop is next after Hamburg Street (Northbound). If you reach Convention Center (Northbound), you've gone too far. Walk Head east on West Camden Street toward South Howard Street. Turn left onto South Howard Street. Turn right onto West Pratt Street. Road name changes to MD-147 / East Pratt Street. Turn right onto MD-2 / Light Street. Turn right. Arrive at Hyatt Regency Baltimore Inner Harbor, 0.4 mile or about 8 minutes. The last intersection before your destination is MD-2/ Light Street.

### [Local Transportation](#)

The Hyatt Regency Baltimore Inner Harbor is conveniently located only four blocks from the Metro subway system and only three blocks from the Light Rail. BUS-MTA (Local Bus – Maryland Transit Administration) picks up right outside the hotel, making it easy to explore the area. Stop by the concierge desk for maps and schedules.

## **CBC COVID-19 PREVENTATIVE CARE MEASURES**

Christian Brothers Conference continues to closely monitor guidance and advisories from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and local health authorities regarding the coronavirus pandemic. ## **CBC COVID-19 PREVENTATIVE CARE MEASURES POLICY**

In order to care for the health and well-being of all our participants, conference participants will be either **fully vaccinated** against COVID-19 (with all doses in the primary series and all booster, recommended for you, when eligible) or **test negative on a rapid antigen test** administered within the 72 hours before the start of the conference on November 17, 2022. If you test positive on the rapid test, you will be unable to attend.

**By registering for the 2022 Huether Conference, you attest and certify that you are fully vaccinated (with all doses in the primary series and all boosters, recommended for you, when eligible) against COVID-19 or will administer a rapid antigen test no more than 72 hours before the start of the conference.**

As of August 2022, the CDC recommends monitoring COVID-19 Community Levels to guide COVID-19 prevention efforts. CDC's COVID-19 Community Levels reflect the current effect of COVID-19 on communities and identify geographic areas that might experience increases in severe COVID-19–related outcomes, based on hospitalization rates, hospital bed occupancy, and COVID-19 incidence during the preceding period. The COVID-19 Community Levels are identified as low, medium or high. **Indoor face coverings are recommended but no longer required for Community Levels identified as low or medium. Indoor face coverings are required for Community Levels that are identified as high.**

## **HYATT REGENCY BALTIMORE INNER HARBOR COVID-19 PREVENTATIVE CARE MEASURES**

**Face Coverings:** In accordance with the CDC updated face covering guidance based on COVID-19 Community Levels, face coverings are no longer required for guests and colleagues in U.S. hotels in a low or medium COVID-19 Community Level, regardless of vaccination status. However, guests and colleagues are encouraged to continue to wear face coverings. In high COVID-19 Community Level areas, face coverings are required and should continue to be worn indoors by all guests and colleagues, regardless of vaccination status.

Participants agree to be bound by any restrictions/directives imposed by the City of Baltimore and/or the Hyatt Regency Baltimore Inner Harbor.
