On Saturday, November 19, we are looking forward to hearing from Lasallians from across the Region in a panel discussion on responding to the signs of the times. Panelists will dialogue on realities experienced and responses that speak to how we build up our communities. Also on Saturday, we have an addition to the Huether schedule. Participants will have an opportunity to participate in a lunch and learn session where they will be assigned a lunch table based on roles at their ministry for networking and sharing of best practices. We look forward to this opportunity for participants to learn from one another in this new format!
