This year's conference theme is "Lasallian Education Today: Integral, Spiritual, Transformational." The planning committee has identified informative, inspiring and knowledgeable presenters from within the Lasallian family who will encourage us to continue building up our Lasallian educational communities while meeting the needs of those entrusted to our care. In addition to a rich, interactive schedule, participants will have the opportunity to experience community throughout the conference through prayer and networking.

We are delighted to welcome Ann Garrido, D.Min., Catholic theologian and thought leader in Christian leadership, to provide a keynote address on Friday, November 22. In her ongoing reflection as an educator and administrator for more than 25 years, Ann will share her passion for bringing the best research and practice around healthy communication and conflict management from the business world into the church world. We also welcome Brother Hernán Santos González, FSC, Ph.D., the current vice chancellor (president) of Bethlehem University, from the Lasallian District of Argentina-Paraguay, as our keynote speaker on Saturday, November 23. Brother Hernán will share insights on his and fellow Lasallians' commitment and passion for transformative education while ministering in an active conflict zone to young people of multiple religious backgrounds and circumstances, and the fortitude needed to do so.

Due to their popularity last year, we are proud to offer conference tracks for this year's Huether. These optional tracks will cover specific subjects of interest within our Lasallian family including:

- Academic, School and College Counselors;
- Association for Mission, for those who have graduated from a significant formation program; and the
- Higher Education Colloquy

In addition to these specialized tracks, we also have a general track for educators (inclusive of all faculty and staff). On the registration form, participants will indicate interest in any particular track. These conference tracks will be confirmed with registered participants prior to Huether. All Huether participants will have the opportunity to select breakout sessions on site.

This year we are delighted to host a pre-conference focused on Athletics. This pre-conference includes athletic directors, student life personnel, presidents and all involved in athletics at their ministry. The pre-conference will begin on Wednesday, November 20 and will conclude prior to Huether on Thursday, November 21. We encourage all to stay after Saturday's closing for a post-conference discussion titled, "The Vocation to Teach 'to

the Ends of the Earth': The Lasallian Pedagogical Vision." This discussion will be facilitated by Brother Ernest Miller, FSC, D.Min., and will create a forum to dive deeper in our vocation and offer a space to focus on Lasallian spirituality.
