Booking Your Stay

Christian Brothers Conference (CBC) Hotel Reservation Policy

The cost of a participant's hotel room is not included in the Huether Conference registration fee and is the sole responsibility of the participant. Participants will be asked on the registration form to acknowledge and agree to the conditions of this policy.

Reservations

Hotel reservations for the Huether Conference can be made online using a booking website that has been created specifically for the event by our partner Nix Conference & Meeting Management. By using the Huether Conference online reservations link through Nix, **participants will receive the discounted conference rate of \$159.00 per person, per night.** The discounted conference rate is quoted exclusive of any applicable taxes (which are currently 17.9%), applicable service fees, and /or hotel-specific fees in effect at the time of the conference. This rate is available from Tuesday, Nov. 18, through Saturday, Nov. 22, 2025, based on availability. Participants should call Nix's reservations toll-free number listed above if questions arise regarding reservations. **All reservations must be accompanied by the first night's room deposit or guaranteed by a major credit card.** The hotel and Nix will not hold any reservations unless secured by one of these methods.

Reservation Cut-off Date

The cut-off to make a reservation in the Huether Conference discounted room block is **5:00 p.m. Eastern Daylight Time (EDT), Tuesday, Oct. 28, 2025, or until the block is sold out.** Please be sure to book your room early. After Oct. 28, or if the block is sold out, the hotel will accept reservations on a space-available basis at the prevailing rate.

Cancellation

Participants may cancel their reservation at no charge before 3:00 p.m., at least 48 hours prior to their arrival date. Please note that the hotel will charge a fee equal to one night's room and tax for cancellations after that time.

Check-in/Checkout

Daily check-in time starts at 4:00 p.m., and checkout time is 11:00 a.m.

Hotel Parking

Valet parking is on-site and available for \$40.00 per day with in/out privileges. Self-parking options are available adjacent to the hotel.

Airport Information

The St. Louis Lambert International Airport (STL) located 14 miles (approximately 20 minutes) from the Hyatt Regency St. Louis at the Arch. The hotel does not provide shuttle service.

Car Rental Companies

Free shuttle service is provided by all rental car companies to off-airport facilities. Please return vehicles directly to the off-site locations. Pick up locations include:

- Terminal 2- Outside Exit 12 (on the inside curb of Arrivals Blvd.)

Taxi

Taxi service is available on a first come, first serve basis. Exact fare depends on final destination. Each taxi will have an Airport Use Fee of \$4 per pickup.

Metro Bus

MetroBus is your connection to almost any destination in the bi-state area. The MetroBus fleet operates a combination of diesel, battery-electric and hybrid buses across more than 50 bus routes across two states, covering a service area of more than 500 square miles. Use the online Trip Planner or download Transit, the official trip-planning app (available on the App Store and Google Play) to plan your trip from your mobile device. [Gateway Arch National Park](#) is a 91-acre urban oasis in St. Louis and offers over five miles of paved paths and ramps, beautiful green spaces and innovative experiences both above and below ground. Whether you have a few hours or a full day, there's plenty to do.

At [St. Louis Union Station](#), the adventure never ends with various indoor and outdoor attractions that promise unforgettable experiences for everyone.

Did you know that [Forest Park](#) in St. Louis is approximately 500 acres larger than Central Park in New York City? Home to world-class attractions – most of which are also free! – it's considered one of the best urban parks in the country.

[Anheuser Busch Brewery](#) was founded in the 1850s as a small neighborhood brewery, and it quickly transformed from a local fixture into a national presence. Today, it serves as a hub for brewing innovation, using the highest-quality ingredients grown by American farmers to produce umpteen brands of beer. St. Louis is home to the titan's flagship brewery, which operates out of elaborate, red-brick buildings. Hop on a tour for a glimpse inside them.

[St. Louis Zoo](#) is a free and fun option that is open year-round, with special events sprinkled throughout the calendar.

Connect with curiosity at the [Saint Louis Science Center](#). Using science to engage people of all ages, this free museum boasts hundreds of hands-on exhibits, one of just nine OMNIMAX Theaters in the world and the largest artificial sky in the Western Hemisphere, located at the James S. McDonnell Planetarium.

[The Fabulous Fox Theater](#) is a magnificently restored theatre in the Grand Center Arts and Entertainment District. It is the perfect venue to see the hottest Broadway shows and concerts. Prices vary; see website for performance schedule.

[Enterprise Center](#) is home to the St. Louis Blues, a member of the Central Division in the Western Conference of the National Hockey League. The St. Louis Blues play home games October through April at Enterprise Center, followed by the Stanley Cup Playoffs. The franchise was founded in 1967 as an expansion team during the league's original expansion from six to 12 teams.
