This year's conference theme is "Building Sacred Bridges: Igniting Our Vocation as Lasallian Educators." The planning committee has identified informative, inspiring and knowledgeable presenters from within the Lasallian family who will focus on the many sacred bridges that we have the opportunity to build as educators to support the young people entrusted to our care as they grow academically, spiritually and socially. This year, the Huether Lasallian Conference will examine teaching as a transformative vocation that shapes both educators and students, fostering a commitment to faith, service and justice. In addition to a rich interactive schedule, participants will have the opportunity to experience community throughout the conference through prayer and networking.

We are delighted to welcome Springtide Research Institute on Friday, Nov. 21. Christian Brothers Conference has partnered with Springtide Research Institute to:

- Uncover how young people express the concept of vocation broadly and specific language they use to talk about related themes: call, purpose, discernment, mission, etc.
- Gain insights into how the youngest generation (Gen Alpha) understands and thinks about vocation.
- Offer insights and recommendations around language and opportunities that resonate with young people to explore the concept of vocation in their lives.

The hope is that the results will provide affirmation, trends and give voice to young people expressing how they make meaning around the abstract notion of vocation, which will empower all who accompany young people to better bridge build in fostering trusted relationships, supporting vocational discernment and responding to the needs of young people through a language and experience that is accessible and relevant.

We also welcome Hosffman Ospino, Ph.D., professor, theology and education and chair, Department of Religious Education and Pastoral Ministry at Boston College as our keynote speaker on Saturday, Nov. 22.

Dr. Ospino will speak compellingly to the spiritual and communal dimensions of teaching and how we accompany students, foster human flourishing and cultivate faith-filled learning communities that embody the Gospel.

We are proud to offer an optional conference track for this year's Huether. The breakout sessions within this track will cover specific subjects of interest for new educators within our Lasallian family. This targeted track is inclusive of those with one to three years' experience in the classroom and anyone new to the Lasallian charism.

In addition to this specialized track, all our participants will follow a general track for educators (inclusive of all faculty and staff). On the registration form, participants will indicate interest in any particular track. All Huether participants will have the opportunity to select breakout sessions on site.

This year will feature a preconference that focuses on Communications professionals. This preconference is open to communications directors, social media managers, writers, graphic designers and those in roles who are involved in communications at their ministry. The pre-conference will begin on Wednesday, Nov. 19 and will conclude prior to Huether on Thursday, Nov. 20.
