We are excited to head back to Houston, Texas to the OMNI Houston Hotel. The LASSCA Conference will begin on **Sunday, March 1, 2026**, with Mass on-site at 6:30 p.m., followed by the opening session at 7:30 p.m., which will include the presentation of the Brother Michael Collins Award of Excellence and an opening social at 8:00 p.m. The conference will conclude at approximately 10:00 a.m. on **Wednesday, March 4, 2026**. We encourage you to arrive early to give yourself plenty of time to explore and enjoy Houston's sunny and warm February weather. General sessions will take place Monday and Tuesday. Payment Procedure
