Dear Chief Administrators and District Leaders,

Advent greetings! We are pleased to provide you with registration materials for the 2026 Lasallian Association of Secondary School Chief Administrators (LASSCA) Conference, taking place March 1 – 4 at the OMNI Houston Hotel in Houston, Texas. The 2026 conference theme is “Anchored in Faith: Leading Lasallian Schools Amid a Shifting Society.” During our time together in Houston, speakers and activities, selected by the planning committee, will call us to reflect on how we are anchored in our shared mission as we lead our schools in our shifting society. We will explore opportunities to deepen our formation and remain attentive to the pressing needs of our educational communities.

We have a dynamic schedule planned for the conference. Sunday evening will begin with Mass at 6:30 p.m., followed by the presentation of the 2026 Brother Michael Collins Award of Excellence and an opening social.

On Monday morning, we will welcome keynote speaker Brother Superior Armin Luistro, FSC, and members of his General Council. Brother Armin will speak to realities facing our Lasallian mission today and will offer updates and inspiration to our school leaders. Monday will also include District meetings and breakout sessions focusing on NIL updates, spirituality of an administrator, crisis communications and Lasallian leadership development programming. In addition to these four topics, we are planning to offer a topical open forum style breakout that would focus on enrollment management. The breakout will offer an opportunity to brainstorm and share practices pertaining to enrollment management strategies (i.e. open house practices, online marketing, student shadow days, etc.). Given the richness and creativity of many of our schools, we hope this format will allow for us to learn from one another on the innovative and creative ways that we consider enrollment management needs in our ministries.

We look forward to sharing more information with you soon on our second keynote speaker. Tuesday will also provide the opportunity to gather for open forums and a second round of concurrent breakout sessions. Our day will conclude with the Districts hosting their dinners this evening.

Wednesday morning we will hear from Catholic policy advocates including experts on the Federal Tax Scholarship program and implications that it will bring to our educational communities.
