This concentration is open to participants of The Buttimer Institute of Lasallian Studies (Buttimer) and The Brother John Johnston Institute of Contemporary Lasallian Practice (JJI). Saint Mary's is pleased to offer a scholarship for participants in the Buttimer and JJI program. Tuition for the Lasallian Education concentration (15 credits) is \$100 per credit.

Participants will earn 15 graduate credits during their participation in Buttimer or JJI through completing additional requirements with a Saint Mary's instructor. Participants must complete the 15-credit core curriculum of the M.A. in Education program to complete the degree. The tuition for the core courses is the standard rate for the M.A. in Education program.

If interested in earning graduate credits, participants must apply at the beginning of Buttimer or JJI.

## M.A. in Education

Saint Mary's M.A. in Education is a 30-credit program that is offered online. The 15-credit core curriculum consists of five required courses. The courses are online (asynchronous) and run eight weeks. Students may enroll in the core courses concurrently or wait until after they conclude Buttimer or JJI.
