You are invited to submit an abstract for a breakout session to be presented during the 2026 Huether Lasallian Conference that will address the conference theme:

Caring for the Whole Child, Renewing the Lasallian Educator

WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR

The 2026 Huether planning committee is accepting abstracts for breakout session presentations of 75 minutes in length that will take place during concurrent sessions on Friday, Nov. 20 and Saturday, Nov. 21. Presentations should emphasize how Lasallians are or could be addressing the theme, “Caring for the Whole Child, Renewing the Lasallian Educator.”

Breakout session presentations will focus on the ways Lasallian ministries nurture the academic, spiritual, social, emotional and personal growth of young people while also sustaining and renewing the vocation of the educator. Lasallian ministries are called to foster environments of care, belonging, accompaniment and hope for both students and those who serve them. This year’s Huether Lasallian Conference will examine how the Lasallian mission calls educators to care for the whole child through relationship-centered education, social-emotional learning, spiritual formation and practices that sustain healthy and mission-driven communities. The planning committee has surfaced the following as possible topics for breakout sessions:

- Sharing practices that embrace a holistic education as we look to form young people academically, socially, emotionally and spiritually in our ministries.
- Examining how student support services including counseling, campus ministry and student life contribute to caring for the whole child.

- Sharing practices that promote educator wellness, balance, self-care and vocational renewal within Lasallian ministries.
- Nurturing the spiritual life of the community through practice, reflection, accompaniment and community-building.
- Exploring practices of accompaniment, discernment and formation that help sustain educators throughout their vocational journey.

During each breakout session, the presenter(s) should focus on how we look at the present and to the future in light of the topic(s).

3. Intended audience (A-all educators; E-elementary school faculty and staff; M-middle school faculty and staff; H-high school faculty and staff; C-college/university faculty and staff; YFS-youth and family services)
4. Objectives/intended outcomes for participants
5. Program abstract (no more than 200 words)
6. A/V needs (LCD projector, screen, lectern and internet for presenter will be provided; **presenter must provide own laptop**)
NOTE: If you are using a Mac computer, please bring the appropriate adapter.
7. Willingness to repeat session

NOTE: You will be notified by email of acceptance of your presentation. Accepted presenters (limited to two per session) will receive a \$100 reduction of the 2026 Huether Lasallian Conference registration fee. All accepted presenters must be registered and paid in full by Friday, Oct. 2, 2026, in order to present.
